

ALL FOR TRI SIGMA!

Objective:

- To motivate the chapter members with enthusiasm for a special project or event

Preparation:

This is a very short and fun program. Examples are given of statements that the membership is either "for" or "against". Your Education Committee should discuss changing these statements the way the membership indicates their position on them during a meeting one or two weeks before presentation of the program. You want to make the program both effective and meaningful for your chapter. This is a creative way to stir up enthusiasm without insisting on attendance or lecturing about participation. You need your best cheerleader to present this program.

Program:

(If moving about the room will be too chaotic, have the members stand if they are for the statement and sit if they are against the statement.)

“Blondes have more fun! - If you agree with this statement, please stand in the front of the room. If you disagree, please stand at the back of the room.”

“Rap music is great to dance to! - same as above”

“_____ is my favorite fraternity! - same as above” (Fill in the blank with a group that will divide the membership.)

If time allows, your Education Committee can come up with additional for/against statements that will divide the chapter.

“Tri Sigma will _____!” - Fill in the blank appropriately. For example, Tri Sigma will win Greek Sing. Tri Sigma will raise \$1,500 at the RPM fundraiser. Tri Sigma will get 10 great new members during recruitment. You pick the statement that means the most to the chapter. It could even be something like, Tri Sigmas will ace their mid-terms!

Close the program with a chant, cheer or short, lively song that is a favorite of the chapter.

Program Follow-Up:

Have members evaluate program. Tabulate evaluations, record on Form K-87W and send to National Headquarters monthly.
