### **Objective:**

- To learn more about The Robbie Page Memorial Fund and its work

### **Preparation:**

Approximately two weeks prior to the presentation of this program, the Education Director will have a meeting of the Education Committee. The Foundation/Robbie Page Memorial Chairman is to be included on the committee for the presentation of this program.

Sufficient copies of the puzzle will need to be made for each participant. Everyone should be reminded to have a pencil or pen for this program.

Perhaps the committee will want to have a contest for the completion of the puzzle. Individuals or pairs could work to see who completes the puzzle correctly first. A small prize will offer added incentive.

The committee may also wish to show the Robbie Page Memorial video tape after the puzzle. The videotape shows Sisters the results of the national programs they support. Each chapter should have purchased a videotape, and have it located in the chapter chest.

### **Program:**

Distribute the puzzle. Allow approximately 10 minutes for its completion. When time is up, the correct answers should be provided and discussed.

If the videotape is to be used, it should be presented immediately after the puzzle discussion.
